Eric Gonzalez: Mr. Space Cadet has done it again! He's taking the MRC 1/12 scale Project Mercury Kit and backdating it to an early Mercury space capsule with the porthole windows. Since the kit comes with the late-model instrument panel, he's also scratch building the early style instrument panel. Why? A kit in 1/12 scale is large enough to make such differences very obvious. In addition, Eric says there are lots of scratch built modifications in the interior which can be found in documentation/photos on the Internet. He plans to have the completed capsule in a quasi-diorama with an aftermarket astronaut figure produced by Shapeways in 3-D printed resin.



Members also asked Eric to list the awards he took home from the recent Wonderfest Sci-Fi and Figure contest, held annually in Louisville, Kentucky. He had 11 entries and here is the summary:

He also took home a special award from the manufacturer of Round 2 Kits for one of his entries.


Ness Gomez: Ness brought a really compact, intricate, but great looking Bandai kit of a Gundam Death Scythe Hell EW (there is no scale noted on the kit box). It's primed and ready for masking for neon glow and black paint for a startling contrast. It looks fantastic now, so it's going to be very attractive when she gets it finished. Looking forward to seeing it next month in all its glory!



Dave Wallace: Dave brought two models to display at tonight's club meeting. The first is a "kit bash" effort that is a work-in-progress (WIP). He's taken a 1/48 scale Fw-190 kit fuselage and added hot rod fenders to it for a post-apocalyptic scenario similar to a Mad Max concept. Looks like it going to be a super-fast motorcycle-type vehicle fit for the streets of Miami at night. Knowing Dave's modeling skill set, we can expect a really interesting finished project in the near future!



Dave is a multi-talented modeler who has myriad interests which include sci-fi models, aircraft, ships, Gundam models, etc. However, he does exquisite ship modeling and tonight he brought his Hasegawa 1/350 scale IJN Mikasa which is a WIP, but is nearly completed. It's awaiting final weathering and full rigging. Dave used photo-etched railings and machined gun barrels for a more realistic effect and intends to use elastic string for the rigging which he will attach with medium viscosity cyano-acrylic glue. Look at what he's already accomplished!
