
## Modelfest 2023 Update:

President East announced that Modelfest 2023 will be held at the Renaissance Charter School of Coral Springs, Florida on Saturday, March 4, 2023. The address is 6250 W Sample RD, Coral Springs FL 33067 (one block west of US 441 on Sample Road). The venue has 6,000 square feet of space, but there won't be separate rooms for display and vendor areas, and the club will have to rent tables. President East did relay information that the charter school would now prep the site for set-up and would clean up the premises as part of any rental. Unfortunately, due to health department restrictions, the school kitchen cannot be used for Modelfest 2023. That means arrangements will need to be made for drink and/or food trucks to be present on the premises. More detailed information will be presented at the October 2022 club meeting.

## \*Show & Tell:

**Eric Gonzalez:** Mr. Gonzalez continues his "space" quest modeling. Tonight he brought examples of 1/72 space kits by two different manufacturers. We've seen the first vehicle before: the MPC kit of the Hawk space ship from the TV series, "Space 1999." Eric is finishing up the exterior painting and detailing of the model and it looks fantastic.







The next "set" of models are 1/72 Mercury space capsules by Horizon Models. The kit contains four (4) separate capsules—two complete capsules and two basic core space craft-- decals and a photo-etched fret for details. To show the scale effect, Eric also brought a 1/72 scale astronaut figure to contrast with the capsules; however, there are no astronauts figures included in the kit. Despite being small/tiny models, they come to life with exsquisite detail.





Jeff Selker: Jeff has been very busy experimenting with 3-D printing. To assist Jim Decker with a diorama that requires a figure of a female Womens' Army Service Pilot (WASP) from WW II, Jeff has 3-D printed some WASPs in various scales, e.g., 1/48 and 1/24 scale. As many of you know, WASPs were utilized to ferry US military aircraft from the factories to military units in the field to free up male pilots for combat flying duties (US female pilots were prohibited from flying combat missions in WW II). Jeff's figures are incredibly realistic and should really complement Jim Decker's future diorama.




Jeff also saw a photo of a female service member painting the nose spinner of a P-51D Mustang while sitting atop a tall ladder. No problem for Jeff—he 3-D printed the painter and the ladder.




Jeff is a consummate car modeler and he brought a Lindberg 1/24 scale 1932 Ford pick-up truck to tonight's meeting. He modified it by chopping the cab and included a 3-D printed custom flathead engine. Quite impressive!








Another idea that Jeff has is to ultimately produce and market his 3-D printed pieces. To this end, he's printed a number of automobile engines and modernized them. They are in 1/24 scale and even include new distributors and wiring, too!





**Jeff East:** One of our other "Jeff's" is Jeff East, the president of IPMS Flight 19. He is presently building an Airfix 1/48 scale Hawker Hurricane for the IPMS Rumrunners' group build. However, he managed to break one of the Hurricane's landing gear and has decided to replace the Airfix kit with a new build using a Tamiya Hawker Hurricane kit. Tonight he brought the Airfix example for "Show and Tell." Frankly, it looks pretty good, but Jeff is s stickler for perfection so the Tamiya kit will replace this Airfix model. You be the judge of whether it's good enough for the Rumrunners' group build!
